Minister Delegate for European Affairs, Victor Negrescu, was born on 17 August 1985, in Bucharest, Romania.

Former Member of the European Parliament (2014 – 2017), Negrescu was the coordinator of S&D40, the network of the young S&D MEPs in the European Parliament.

Winner of the *MEP Award 2015* for Digital Agenda, Victor Negrescu was also the youngest Romanian MEP to get ever elected in the European Parliament and he was the youngest ever vice-president of the Social Democratic Party of Romania (PSD), between 2015 and 2018.

President of PES activits Romania, an organization gathering more than 10.000 members interested in European issues and politics, he is also a university techer and former digitalentrepreneur with an MBA in executive business and a PhD in development cooperation.

He started his professional career as a journalist at *Radio France Internationale*, collaborating in parallel with the presitigous magazines *Le Monde diplomatique* and *Regard*.

Victor Negrescu is also the founder of the *Romanian Foundation for a Democratic Left*, gathering respected left wing Romanian intellectuals of the new wave.
