Minister Delegate for European Affairs, Victor Negrescu, was born on 17 August 1985, in Bucharest, Romania.

Former Member of the European Parliament (2014 – 2017), Negrescu was the coordinator of S&D40, the network of the young S&D MEPs in the European Parliament.

Winner of the *MEP Award 2015* for Digital Agenda, Victor Negrescu was also the youngest Romanian MEP to get ever elected in the European Parliament and he was the youngest ever vice-president of the *Social Democratic Party of Romania (PSD)*, between 2015 and 2018.

President of PES activists Romania, an organization gathering more than 10.000 members interested in European issues and politics, he is also a university teacher and former digital entrepreneur with an MBA in executive business and a PhD in development cooperation.

He started his professional career as a journalist at *Radio France Internationale*, collaborating in parallel with the prestigious magazines *Le Monde diplomatique* and *Regard*.

Victor Negrescu is also the founder of the *Romanian Foundation for a Democratic Left*, gathering respected left wing Romanian intellectuals of the new wave.
