(i) Please note that to become a participant in the Symposium, all you need to do is apply for participation until **April 26th**.

(ii) Those who would like to present a paper should send their paper abstract (350 words) by filling the participant application form no later than **April 26th**

Some Notes

a) The Symposium will be held in English. Therefore, all abstracts and full papers should be in English. There will be no Turkish panel this year.

b) All sessions of the Symposium will be held on Zoom Webinar, resting sessions on Zoom Meeting format. The final schedule will be sent to your mail address submitted in the registration form.

- c) Registration at the Symposium is free of charge.
- d) Those who will not present a paper may apply as a participant until April 26th.
- e) Each presenter will have 15 minutes for their presentation and 5 minutes allocated for questions and answers.
- f) The Symposium will be certificated via e-mail. Paper presenters will receive an additional certificate.
- g) Authors will be invited to submit the final version of the selected papers to a Special Issue of the *Justitia et Fides*, subject to a double-blind peer-review procedure. However, acceptance of a paper for this call does not guarantee its acceptance for publication.
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1. Format of Articles

- Articles must be submitted in Microsoft Word format.
- Articles should be written in Times New Roman font style and 12 pt. c) There should be 2.5 cm margins on each side of the page, and the text should be justified.
- Pages should be numbered.
- Articles cannot be less than 2000 words and more than 5000 words. Footnotes and bibliography sections are not included in this issue. f) Written language is English.

2. Footnotes

- Footnotes should be written in Times New Roman font style, 10 font size.
- The order of the footnotes should be uniform.
- Abbreviations in footnotes can be made.

3. Plagiarism

- Articles with plagiarism in their content will be excluded from evaluation after notification to the author.
